Home Safety Inspection – Home Care Package

The Home Safety Inspection has been designed to assist the homeowner to achieve and maintain a level of compliance in line with current WHS legislation regarding community workers in their homes and for the safety of themselves and property.

The program covers fire & electrical safety, access corridors and to identify and report on potential safety hazards within and around the dwelling.

All homes will have to be assessed on an individual basis as they will have different levels of existing compliance.

The Home Safety Inspection allows us to work from a standard set of guidelines and report on any areas that may need to be brought up to compliance standards in line with current legislation. Once the dwelling meets the required safety standards, we can issue the relevant compliance certificates.

When a dwelling has met current compliance standards, this program will enable the dwelling to be maintained at a compliance level of safety standard and allow us to further identify potential problem areas.

Inspections are available in either of two options, basic and premium, and can be discussed with your Aged Care provider as to which best suits your needs.
